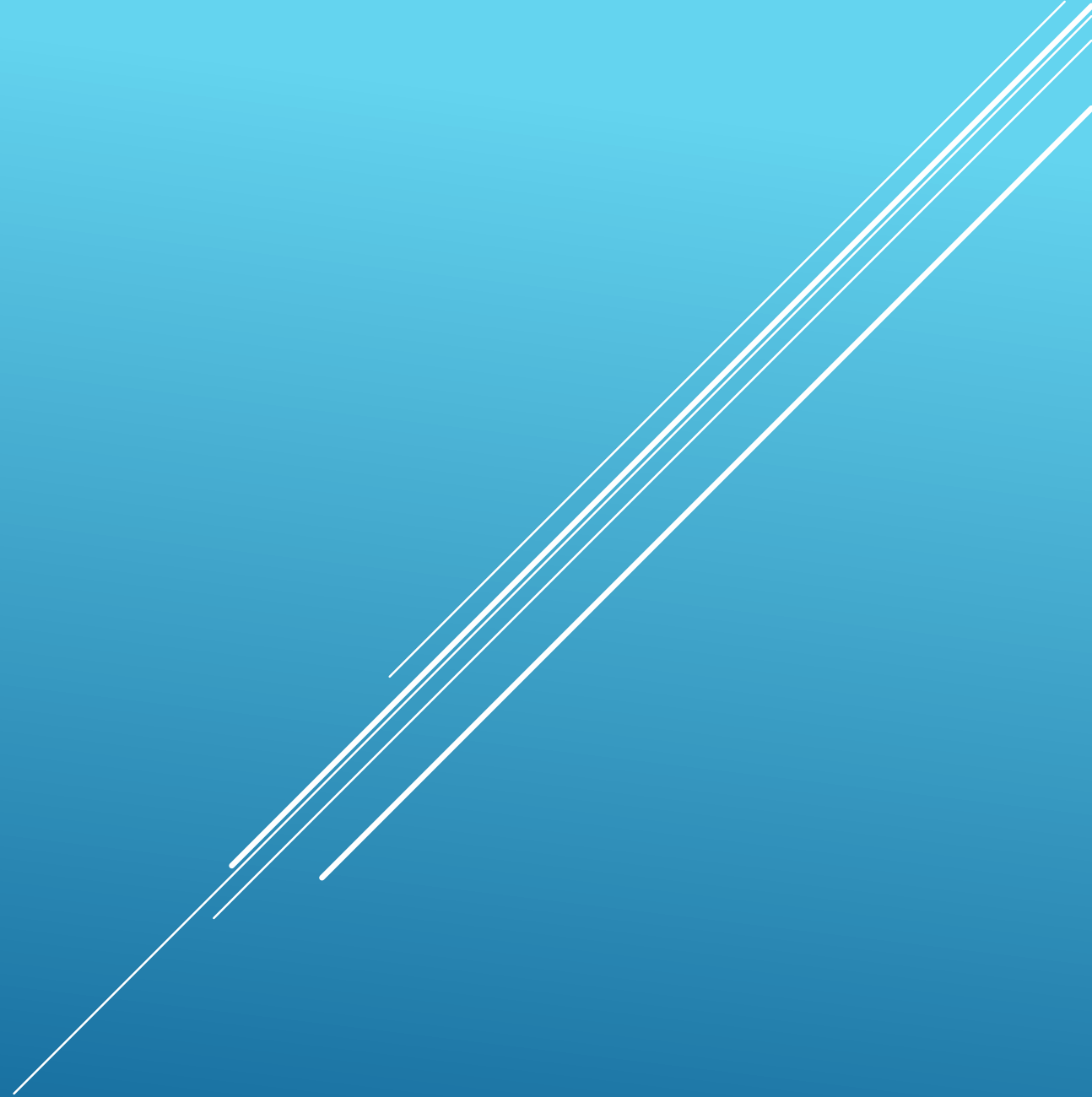


INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE



WHAT IS IT?

The IB program is for Juniors and Seniors and aims to develop students who flourish physically, intellectually, emotionally and ethically.

What the IB offers students--

THE CORE

- Theory of knowledge, in which students reflect on the nature of knowledge and on how we know what we claim to know.
 - The extended essay, which is an independent, self-directed piece of research, finishing with a 4,000-word paper.
 - Creativity, activity, service, in which students complete a project related to those three concepts.

WHO IS THIS FOR?

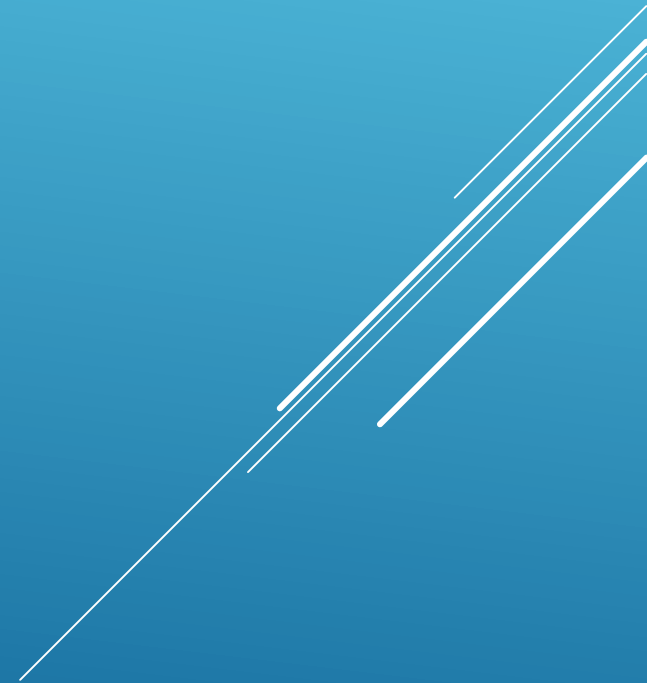
The profile aims to develop learners who are:
